- **A World View of High Speed Rail** featuring the latest developments from Europe and presentations by Siemens Marketing and Business Development Director Wayne Williams, TRAC Vice President Dan McNamara, and former California Senate President Pro-Tem James R. Mills.
- **A new financial structure for state-supported service**, featuring Dennis Kuklis from Amtrak, and Warren Weber, Chief of Caltrans Division of Rail presenting the state of the State Rail Program.
- **Missed Marketing Opportunities**, featuring James R. Mills presenting a case his-

tory on the Cardinal and TRAC President Richard Tolmach giving an update on California Corridors.

- **TRAC Member's Forum** on issues and priorities for the organization, end of the session on Saturday.

Also, on Sunday, we will host a tour of the downtown section of Regional Transit's new South Line.

Two blocks from the event and two blocks from the train station. \$89

Clarion Hotel 700 16th Street (916) 444-8000
A couple of blocks to Alkali Flat station and a short light rail ride and another couple of blocks walk from 8th & Capitol station. Walk west to Tower Bridge. \$69.

Sheraton Grand Sacramento 1230 J Street (916) 447-1700

Walk down the K Street Mall to Old Sacramento, or take 30 bus on L Street to Old Sac and walk the rest of the way. \$99

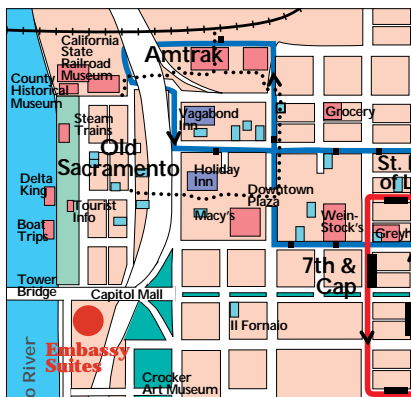
The following Motel 6's are in the \$49 range:

Business Loop I-80 at the N Street exit (916) 457-0777; walk down to R Street and catch light rail WB to 8th & Capitol. Walk west to Tower Bridge.

Motel 6 North Sacramento #1305
I-5 at Richards Blvd (916) 441-0733; By Sacramento standards fairly nearby but due to geography probably requires a car for access to meeting.

Motel 6 Sacramento Central #1005
US-50 at Howe Ave (916) 383-8110; Several miles east; walk to Power Inn light rail station and go WB to 8th & Capitol. Walk west to Tower Bridge.
